

The 1906 Transcontinental Run Album

Messrs. Whitman, Carris, Daley, Bates, and Harris divided into two teams to drive a 1906 Type-H six-cylinder Franklin from San Francisco to New York between August 2nd and 17th, 1906. This was a record-breaking achievement, and The H.H. Franklin Club is fortunate to have an album of 94 original pictures from this 4100-mile trip. These photographs were professionally scanned and adjusted at high resolution with each picture file being about 25 Mbytes.

The files have been converted to lower resolution and collected into a PDF file of reasonable size and presented without selection or editing to represent as complete a historical record as possible. The pictures are in the order that they appear in the album which is not chronological. The high-resolution scans are available to club members upon application to the librarian (*library@franklincar.org*).

The Franklin company used Mr. Whitman's account of the trip as an advertisement brochure for the 1907 model cars which is also available on the Club's website (call no. A-07-02).
















